**2010 IHSAA "LEGENDS OF THE GAME"**

The Idaho High School Activities Association is pleased to announce the 2010 "Legends of the Game" recipients. The award was established in 2001 to help preserve the heritage of Idaho high school sports by honoring great teams of the past. Eligible basketball "Legends" include girls' teams from at least 20 years ago and boys' teams from at least 30 years ago. Ceremonies honoring "Legends" recipients will take place during halftime of the state 5A basketball championship games at the Idaho Center. The girls' ceremonies are slated for February 20 and the boys' ceremonies will take place on March 6.

**Girls' Basketball – Homedale - 1980**

Homedale High School's 1980 basketball team, under the direction of Coach Dean Vance, is the ninth recipient of the IHSAA girls "Legends of the Game" award. Not only were the 1980 Trojans state champions, they are the only state girls' basketball champions in the history of Homedale High School. These outstanding girls were champions on the court as well as in the classroom and were wonderful role models for the young girls in their community.

**Boys' Basketball – American Falls – 1946**

American Falls High School's 1946 basketball team has been chosen as the tenth IHSAA boys "Legends of the Game". Under the direction of coach Ron Pierson, this talented group of young men finished their season with a record of 32-1 on their way to the state title. This American Falls High School team played in and won more games than any other boys' basketball team in the history of Idaho.
