

<p style="text-align: center;">Idaho High School Activities Association Hall of Fame Awards</p>

I. Purpose

The purpose of the Hall of Fame is to preserve the heritage of high school activities in Idaho by honoring outstanding individuals of exemplary character who have excelled through meritorious long-time service and superior achievement.

II. Eligibility

Hall of Fame inductees shall be individuals who through distinguished achievement and long-term contributions have made significant, positive impact on IHSAA member schools, students, sports and/or activities. Current IHSAA Board members are not eligible for Hall of Fame awards; nor shall they nominate individuals for Hall of Fame awards. Nominees shall be retired.

Nominations will be solicited from district Boards of Control and member schools, but will also be accepted from other sources within the educational community.

Nominees may include the following:

Nominees (a) (b) (c) shall have served for at least twenty-five years, with at least 20 of those being in Idaho. Nominees (f) must have been graduated from high school for at least twenty-five years.

III. Selection

- a. Nominations are due by November 15. Applications will be sent to nominees and must be returned to the IHSAA office by January 1 to be considered for the current year. Nominations will remain active for a three-year period and may be renewed once.
- b. A screening committee from the IHSAA Board of Directors will present up to ten finalists for the entire Board's approval at the January meeting. Finalists' identities will remain confidential.
- c. Anonymous selectors from all areas of the state will independently evaluate and rate the finalists' applications.
- d. Selectors' ratings will be totaled and presented by number only to the IHSAA Board of Directors at the April meeting. Inductees will be selected by the Board based on point totals. Identities of inductees will be revealed only after the number for induction has been determined.

IV. Applications

- a. Applications must be typewritten and shall not exceed four pages.
- b. Applications may also include up to three letters recommendations or three pages of supporting documentation, or a combination of letters/supporting materials.
- c. A recent portrait-style photograph should accompany the application
- d. Applications received after the due date will be held until the following year.
