The Agenda was approved and added approval of DB Fitzpatrick handling IHSAA investments funds as a Final Reading to the Action Agenda and removed from the Discussion Agenda the format of the State Cheer and Dance and the classification of charter and private schools.

CONSENT AGENDA

The Consent Agenda was approved. This included Minutes from the January 18, 2011 Board of Directors Meeting, the January 1– March 31, 2011 financial report, the 2011 girls' and boy's basketball team reimbursements, the 2011 wrestling team reimbursements for Dist. I-II, and IHSAA Board of Directors action via phone, e-mail, and fax.

REPORT AGENDA

Y.E.A. Update

Dick Curtis reported on the Youth Endowment for Activities. The fund balance as of March 23, 2011 stands at just over three million dollars. Travel reimbursements for schools that participated in state tournaments for Drama, Cross Country, and Cheer/Dance total \$27,072. This figure is more than half of what was reimbursed last year, with state speech, softball, golf and track yet to be completed.

2011 Winter Tournaments

John Billetz reported on the State Girls' Basketball Tournament held in February. Julie Hammons reported on the Legends of the Game ceremony honoring the 1978 team from Highland of Craigmont.

John Billetz reported on the State Wrestling Tournament held at The Idaho Center in Nampa.

John Billetz reported on the Boys' State Basketball Tournament held in March. Exploring options for an alternate 4A site was suggested. Julie Hammons reported on the Legends of the Game ceremony honoring the 1948 Lewiston team.

Web-Casting of IHSAA Winter State Tournaments

John Billetz reported on the web-casting of winter tournaments by Idahosports.com. Viewers signed in from all fifty states, plus the District of Columbia, as well as from 65 other countries. The possibility of charging for web-viewing was discussed.

2011 State Debate

Julie Hammons reported on the State Debate Tournament that was held at Canyon Ridge in Twin Falls. Participation was down slightly from last year as smaller schools seem to be dropping the program.

Proposed Resolutions for the 2011 Annual Meeting

John Billetz reported that no resolutions have been submitted to be voted on at the Annual Meeting.

Schools of Excellence

Julie Hammons reported on the 2010-11 Schools of Excellence program. Academic reports for activities (band, speech arts, etc.) may be submitted until May. The Citizenship component of the program, which is a self-assessment of a school's sportsmanship initiatives, is due by May 15. Information and forms can be found on the IHSAA website.

State Dance/Cheer Championships

Julie Hammons reported on the State Dance and Cheer Championships held at the Idaho Center on March 19. The event was co-sponsored by ICDC and the IHSAA. The split of the revenue after expenses will be sixty percent to ICDC and forty percent to the IHSAA. Future championships will be two-day events rather than one day. With nearly 1,500 students participating, a one-day event is no longer realistic. Changing the revenue split would likely be an appropriate action. ICDC will be requested to come to the June meeting with a report.

IHSAA Awards

Julie Hammons reported on the Sportsmanship Awards for the girls' and boys' basketball tournaments as well as the winners of the winter Academic State Champions. The 2010-11 Interscholastic Star Scholarship winners will be determined in May and is the only award (other than the Spirit of Sport) that recognizes individual students.

Licensing Resource Group (LRG)

John Billetz reported on the checks written to member schools as part of an agreement with LRG. Schools receive a percentage of school-specific merchandise sold in area stores. Individual schools will now be responsible for signing a contract with LRG rather than one through the IHSAA. The IHSAA does not keep their allowable percentage, but gives it back to the member schools receiving checks.

UDI Sweatshirts

John Billetz reported on the first distribution of sweatshirts donated by the UDI to state tournament participants. Dance/Cheer and Baseball participants will not receive sweatshirts this year, but will likely be added next year if the program is continued. The sweatshirt donation by UDI is a year-by-year agreement.

Classification Committee Report

Gerry Nutt reported on the meeting of the Classification Committee that met in February. Seven proposals were submitted and reviewed by the Committee, with an eighth proposal coming from the committee itself. Balancing classification numbers, travel, and reducing the number of three/four team leagues were studied. Sixty percent of member schools returned the survey to the IHSAA. One proposal will be submitted to the IHSAA board in June. April enrollment numbers have yet to be collected. Schools who did not respond to the survey will be requested to send in their vote on the proposals.

Committee Reports

The Budget Committee reviewed tournament reimbursements, gates and IHSAA funds to be invested.

The Representation Committee set representation for 2012 softball and track.

The Tournament Committee discussed the 4A boys’ basketball site and the format of the Dance/Cheer tournament, as well as a survey to be sent out for State Soccer site requirements.

NFHS Coaches Education – Concussion in Sports

John Billetz reported on data received from the NFHS concerning the Concussion in Sports courses. Idaho had 4,902 coaches and officials that have taken the course in the last nine months.

Football Helmet Reconditioning

John Billetz reported on a notice received from the National Athletic Equipment Reconditioners Association (NAERA). NAERA announced that effective September 1, 2011, NAERA members will not recondition/recertify any football helmet ten years of age or older. The ten years shall be determined by the manufacturers date as required by NOCSAE document 001.

Rule 17-2-3

Adding sport specific/athletic class language to IHSAA Rule 17-2-3 was approved as a Final Reading.

- a. No more than two students may be coached at one time by a member of their high school (grades 9-12) staff of that sport during the school year. (i.e., A boys basketball coach may coach girls basketball players of the same school and vice versa.)
- b. *Sport-specific or athletic classes offered during the regular school day must meet the following criteria:*
 - 1. *Must be open to all students.*
 - 2. *Must be a class for credit.*
 - 3. *If the coach is teaching the class, he/she must be the teacher of record for that class.*

Rules 2-3-1 and 2-3-2

Revising IHSAA Rules 2-3-1 and 2-3-2 was approved as a First Reading with modification of wording before the Final Reading. The revision adds "c. *No petitions can be submitted mid-cycle*" to Rule 2-3-1 and "d. *No petitions can be submitted mid-cycle*" to Rule 2-3-2. The Board asked for language to clarify the term "mid-cycle" before the Final Reading.

2011 Hall of Fame

Three individuals were approved to be inducted into the IHSAA Hall of Fame and the 2011 Memorial Award Recipients were named as a Final Reading.

Rule 17-2-6

Revising Rule 17-2-6 Protective Equipment was approved as a FINAL Reading with modification of wording to note that the first two days must be used as helmet/pad conditioning before the 7 consecutive days of equipment use.

17-2-6 Protective Equipment No school-owned uniforms and/or protective equipment may be used without written permission from the IHSAA. With that permission, schools may use their own protective equipment in a camp or clinic for a period of *eleven (11) days* upon written request from the trustees of the school. Included in the request shall be a statement of recognition that IHSAA sponsored catastrophic insurance provides no coverage for the activity and any and all liabilities rest solely with the school, camp, or clinic.

Individual students from a specific school are not required to use the school's protective equipment in the same camp as other team members. Each individual student will only be allowed to use an IHSAA member school's protective equipment by renting or loaning for a period of *eleven (11) consecutive days*. *The follow guidelines will apply: two (2) days with helmets (MANDATORY), two (2) days with helmets and shoulder pads (MANDATORY), seven (7) days in full pads.*

DISCUSSION AGENDA

1. Awarding of a trophy bid for the next three years will be placed on the Action Agenda of the June Meeting as a Final Reading.
2. Moving the State Wrestling Tournament at the request of the wrestling coaches to the week before the girls' state basketball tournament was discussed. Only 24 schools responded to the survey that was sent out by the Boys' Coaches representative.

The following items were moved to the Action Agenda of the June meeting as a First Reading:

Changing the wrestling match limitations to 15 dates and 50 matches

The 2 lb growth allowance date of January 15

Practice before weight certification

3. A Free Recruiting Webinar was discussed. The company would like to place a link on the IHSAA website.
Placing a link for the Free Recruiting Webinar on the IHSAA website was moved to the Action Agenda of the June meeting.
4. Revision of Rule 4-3-3 was discussed. Soccer officials struggle with getting ejection decisions to the school representatives at a game site as per the current rule. Allowing officials to notify the schools differently from physically handing a notice to a school representative before they leave the game site was requested.
No action was taken.
5. An upcoming Impact Coaching Summit tentatively scheduled for July 16 or 23 was discussed. The people involved in this are asking the IHSAA to send out information to member schools.
No action was taken.
6. A request to consider a two-three-year waiver on accreditation for a school desiring to become a Regular Member was discussed.
Consideration of allowing a two-three year waiver for schools seeking accreditation through third party organizations not yet recognized by Northwest Accreditation was moved to the Action Agenda of the June meeting.
