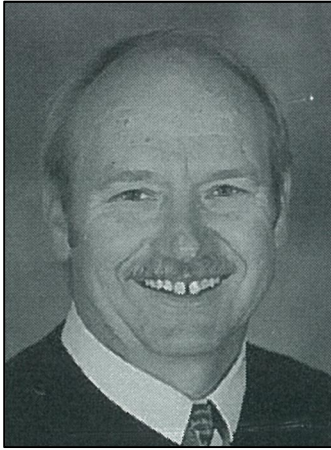


Bill Leaf – 2011 Hall of Fame Inductee



Bill Leaf made a positive and significant impact as a teacher, coach, and administrator for thirty-six years. Bill began his career in 1967 as a math and vocal music teacher as well as a track coach in Tacoma, Washington. After five years in Tacoma, Bill moved to Cascade where he worked as a teacher, coach, and administrator until his retirement in 2004. During his thirty-two-year tenure at Cascade High School, Bill worked tirelessly for the students and faculty and helped the music and track programs grow and develop into powerhouses.

Among Bill's many career highlights and accomplishments are receiving the District III 1A North Boys Track Coach of the Year award an unbelievable thirteen times. He was also awarded the Presidential Award from the Idaho Education Technology Association in 2000 and the Award of Merit from the Treasure Valley Music Educators in 1995.
