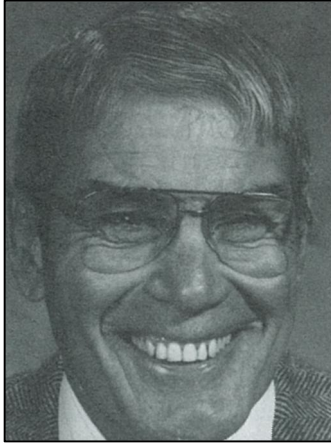


Dwight Church – 1990 Hall of Fame Inductee



Dwight Church graduated from Lewiston High School where he competed in football, basketball, baseball, and track. After high school he spent three years in the U.S. Navy in the South Pacific. He taught and coached for 34 years in the Lewiston Public School District.

Dwight's real love was baseball as he coached the Lewiston High School team for 30 years and the American Legion Baseball team for over 34 years. His team won seven state championships with a total record of 673-231, and in American Legion his teams earned the state title 27 times. He was the first Idahoan to serve on the National Federation Baseball Rules-making Committee.

Dwight received many awards, including induction into the North Idaho Hall of Fame; North Idaho Coach of the Decade; and the 25-year award as a baseball coach by the Inland Empire Sportswriters and Broadcasters.
