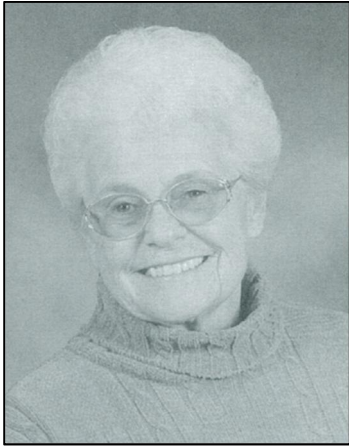


Gail Foltz – 2004 Hall of Fame Inductee



A dedicated teacher and coach for forty-three years and instrumental in the advancement of girls' track in northern Idaho, Gail Foltz spent the majority of her career in Grangeville. Her first few years were divided between the junior high and the high school, but, in 1977, she moved permanently to Grangeville High School where she remained until retiring in 2003.

As head track coach and assistant basketball coach, Gail excelled in providing quality athletic opportunities for female students in Grangeville. Gail started the girls' track and field program in 1977 and, in twenty-one seasons, built it into a powerhouse. Her teams won fourteen district/regional championships, placed in the top five at the state meet nine times and, in 1996, won the A-3 championship.
