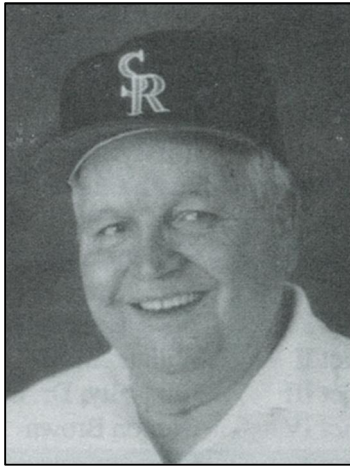


Keith Williams – 1993 Hall of Fame Inductee



Keith Williams graduated from Malad High School in 1943 before going into the Army Air Force Cadet program and serving for 32 months during World War II. His coaching career includes being the head coach in basketball, track, wrestling, football, baseball, and cross country.

Keith distinguished himself as the winningest wrestling coach in the nation in 1983. His record stands at 403 dual meet victories, 69 losses, and 33 ties in his 33 years of coaching. His wrestling teams won six state championships, finished second eight times, third place three times, and fourth place once. He also coached three championship winning baseball teams. Williams was recognized with nine "Idaho Wrestling Coach of the Year" awards and the 1983 National High School Coach of the Year award.
