

Nolan Mecham – 1998 Hall of Fame Inductee



Nolan Mecham is well-known around the state of Idaho, having been involved in statewide organizations, but his contributions are particularly notable in District V. He was one of the primary contributors for promoting and helping plan and meet the guidelines set by the IHSAA that led to the implementation of district and state softball tournaments.

In 1986 Nolan wrote and secured a grant to build a three-story tower for the football field at Snake River High School, then he helped build it. In 1987 he organized, planned, and secured volunteers to put in a six-lane asphalt track. Nolan was also very supportive of the speech arts programs and helped reintroduce competitive speech and debate programs to Snake River High School.
