

Peggy Peterson – 2000 Hall of Fame Inductee



Peggy Peterson will long be remembered for her role in the establishment of girls' athletics in Idaho. She came to Pocatello in 1961 before moving to Highland in 1969. She started all team sports programs for women at the high school and junior high level in Pocatello.

Peggy's coaching career was filled with highlights including: her team winning the state championship in their first trip to state; never having a losing season during 18 years of coaching basketball ending with a career record of 240-67; coaching all fifteen girls' track events while helping the team finish second at state; and reaching state volleyball in eleven of her fifteen years. Peggy was also responsible for starting the Idaho Coaches of Girls' Sports organization and served as the District V Rep to the State Board of Coaches.
