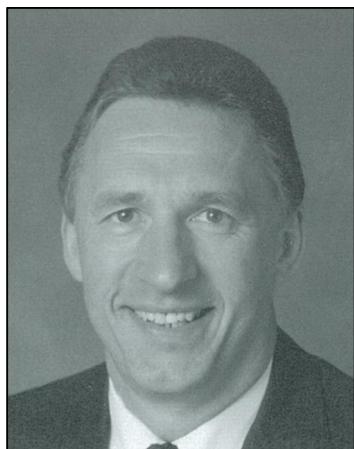


Rex Johnson – 2005 Hall of Fame Inductee



Rex Johnson made a positive and significant impact as a teacher, coach, and administrator for thirty-five years. In his early years, Rex taught and coached for five years at Eagle Junior High before moving to Meridian High School in 1971. For the next twenty years, he coached basketball, football, and track, then served as activities director and assistant principal. In 1991, Rex became principal of Centennial High School and spent ten years in that position before retiring in 2001.

Described as a model of innovative and supportive leadership, Rex spent his career as an ardent promoter of sportsmanship, character education, and the value of participating in interscholastic activities. Through the years, he has been a mentor for numerous young educators, helping them to become excellent teachers, coaches, and administrators.
