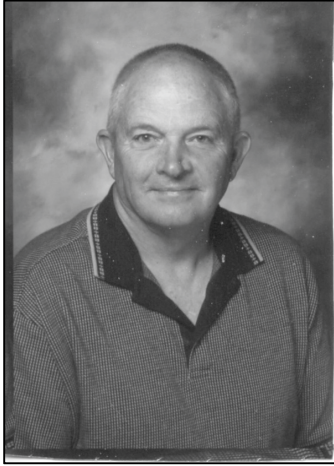


Terry Jones – 2009 Hall of Fame Inductee



Terry Jones dedicated himself to student athletes for thirty-five years, beginning at Hawthorne Junior High School in Pocatello where he spent ten years as a teacher, coach, and athletic director before moving to Malad in 1981. For twenty-five years, Terry served Malad High School as a teacher, multi-sport coach, and athletic director before retiring in 2006.

Terry's coaching resume at Malad is outstanding. He coached basketball for twenty-five years, amassing a 481-157 record and winning six state titles. He started the track and cross country programs, running the first years without a track, and almost single-handedly built both programs into regional powerhouses. In twenty-four years as head cross country coach, Terry's teams won a combined 8 state titles and seven runner-up finishes. His boys track team won six state championships. He received numerous district and state Coach of the Year awards and was inducted into the Idaho Track and Field Hall of Fame in 1994.
